



INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING OBJECTION TO THE MOTION TO APPROVE THE SUPPLEMENTAL TERM SHEET BETWEEN THE DEBTORS AND THE SECTION 1114 COMMITTEE

DP3 has heard from many of our pilots that they want to object to the methodology proposed in the Supplemental Term Sheet proposed by the 1114 Committee. The primary objection we have heard is that the proposal gives a claim of only \$2100 to each retiree (or \$4200 for retiree and spouse) for the loss of medical benefits if that retiree was not enrolled in the Delta Pilots Medical Plan during 2006 or 2007. We have heard from many of you that you left the plan in 2005 because of Delta's termination of your Non-qualified Benefits and the termination of those benefits left you looking for a less expensive option at that time.

As a service to our members who want to object, we have prepared a template for filing an objection with a certificate of service that lists the names and addresses of the parties who will need to receive a copy of the objection. You will need to complete those portions of the objection that describe your situation. **THIS OBJECTION MUST BE SENT SO THAT IT WILL BE RECEIVED BY THE COURT AND THE LISTED PARTIES BY 4:00 P.M.(prevailing Eastern time) ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2007 IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED AT THE HEARING ON FEBRUARY 22, 2007.**

Our attorneys have advised us that DP3 cannot and does not express any opinion on the likelihood of the success of such objections nor does it advocate that all retirees object to this Motion. We urge you to consult your own financial and legal advisors about whether you have an objection and whether it should be pursued.

Replace all the red italicized data with your own personal information throughout the document. Fill in the blanks in paragraphs 1 and 2. Replace the italicized instructions in paragraphs 3 through 6 with your own comments. The terms of the Motions and Procedures order require that all parties listed must be served by 4pm Eastern time Friday, Feb. 9, 2007. Fax numbers are provided where available, but the others must be mailed, overnight if necessary to meet the deadline.
