

An October 19, 2006 Associated Press report on the Committee's agreement with Delta drastically misstated the terms of the agreement. The Associated Press published a correction on October 20, 2006, as follows:

NEW YORK - In an Oct. 19 story about a judge's decision to allow Delta Air Lines Inc. to cut medical benefits for retirees, The Associated Press reported erroneously that the company would pay all the medical costs for pilots under age 65. Those under 60 will continue to pay the entire cost of their health insurance premiums, while those aged 60 to 64 will pay between 28 percent and 51 percent, as of Jan. 1.
