If you are enrolling in other coverage such as the DALRC Medical Plan and therefore do not need Delta coverage, you must actively enroll in the "NO COVERAGE" option during the Open Enrollment period.

Failure to do this will result in Delta charging you a premium for your default coverage.

Read page 1 of the DPMP OPEN ENROLLMENT WORKSHEET and PAGES 3 & 4 of the DPMP OPEN ENROLLMENT NOTIFICATION.

It is a Medicare Part D plan.

If you enroll in this plan you do not need to enroll in any other prescription drug plan. To be eligible for the DALRC Medicare Part D prescription drug plan you must be enrolled in Medicare Part A or B.
