

## **Two Hearings in Delta Case Postponed**

ATLANTA - Two Delta Air Lines Inc. bankruptcy hearings were postponed Friday, a day after a new judge was permanently assigned to replace the previous judge who stepped down for health reasons.

Hearings scheduled for Jan. 19 and Feb. 2 have been rescheduled for Feb. 6, at Hardin's direction, court papers said. Some of the matters that were to be taken up at those hearings, including a motion regarding antitrust claims, will be heard at a later date that has not yet been determined.

Atlanta-based Delta, the nation's third-largest carrier, filed for Chapter 11 protection in New York on Sept. 14.
