

Over 65 Medical Plan Enrollment Packets on the Way

The enrollment packets for Delta retirees over the age of 65 are currently in the process of being mailed to all eligible participants. Originally, the enrollment packets were scheduled to be mailed no later than November 13th however, due to the need to have the information reviewed by several different parties prior to going to print; there was a delay in the original estimated date of the mailing. We are asking you to please carefully read and evaluate the "DALRC Plan for Delta Retirees" and make your decision as soon as possible, regarding your participation in the plan.

The deadline for returning the completed enrollment form has been extended to December 8, 2006 for returning your enrollment forms in order to receive your prescription drug card by January 01, 2007.

This is not the cutoff date for enrollment, the plan will continue to enroll eligible members after December 08, 2006 however, Marsh, the Plan Administrator cannot guarantee receipt of the drug card by January 01, 2007 if you enroll after that date. Please remember, if your household has 2 people that are currently eligible for coverage through Delta and one or both of those participants are over the age of 65, you will no longer be eligible for coverage under the Delta Family Care Medical Plan.

IF your household has one spouse eligible for the under 65 program and one spouse that is eligible for the over 65 program, you will receive one packet from the DALRC Medical Plan for Delta Retirees and one packet from Delta (United Health Care)

and each participant must enroll separately in the plan they are qualified for.

You must be both Medicare eligible AND over the age of 65 to enroll in the DALRC Plan.

You cannot be over 65 to enroll in the Delta United Health Care Plan.
