

**STATEMENT OF DELTA AIR LINES REGARDING
MOTION TO APPROVE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN
THE DEBTORS AND SECTION 1114 RETIREE
COMMITTEES TO MODIFY RETIREE BENEFITS**

The approval hearing for the Motion to Approve Agreements Between the Debtors and Section 1114 Retiree Committees to Modify Retiree Benefits is October 19, 2006. Pursuant to the terms of the Case Management Order entered by the Bankruptcy Court for these cases, the objection deadline for the Motion is October 12, 2006 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time).

Although Delta does not believe that individual Delta retirees may validly object to agreements to modify retiree benefits to which their Section 1114 authorized representatives have already agreed (and reserves its right to oppose the validity of any such objections), it will not contest the timeliness of any objection that is properly filed and received by the Court, Delta and the other Core Parties (as defined under the Case Management Order) by Monday, October 16, 2006 at 12 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time).

All filings must be made in accordance with the procedures outlined in the Case Management Order. Please note that, as the Bankruptcy Court observed in the Notice entered on September 20, 2006, faxes and emails to the Court are not permitted.
